SPORT DESCRIPTION:

Open Unisex Solo Piper: Performs without drum accompaniment; choice of tune played; tune shall be 2 ½ to 3 minutes.

Open Unisex Solo Drummer: Perform with a piper they provide; choice of tune; tune shall be 2 ½ to 3 minutes.

Open Unisex Solo Drum Major: Shall compete by performing with the winning band.

Open Unisex Band: Minimum band size two (2) piper and one (1) snare drummer. Band shall perform in a semi-circle. Choice of tunes. Tunes shall be 3 ½ to 4 minutes.

Pipe and Drum competitions are common throughout the world. Bands fall into grades 1 (best) to 5 (beginner). Public safety bands most generally concentrate on a core set of tunes to bring honor to the fallen or tradition to department ceremonies. These tunes mostly include marches and slow aires. This competition will be public safety based.

NOTE: The Federation currently has a team limit of 20 members. If you plan to register for this event and you have more than twenty members please notify the coordinator BEFORE you register so that we may amend our limit.
