— he would marry Marion Martin, who would teach in Capay School for many years. As new teacher she boarded with the Frank Duncan family in Capay, and Clarence, who had grown up with Frank and his cousin Wyatt Godfrey Duncan, jr., would eventually work for Wyatt's mother, widow Mary Duncan on the Duncan Ranch in Hungry Hollow, where he met his future bride. They courted and wed in 1920, honeymooning in SF for 2 lovely weeks and then set up household in a primitive home in Capay with an outdoor "privy." Marion would also teach at Esparto.
