Ridgewood Association Beach Rules

June, 2020

- 1. The beach is closed from 10:00 PM until 5:00 AM
- 2. All cars must display an authorized Ridgewood association beach sticker in the lower left hand corner of the windshield (to be seen from outside). Any cars not having a sticker may be towed at owner's expense.
- 3. Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult when using the beach facilities. For the purpose of using the beach facilities, an adult is considered to be someone 16 years of age or older.
- 4. Members <u>must</u> accompany their guest(s) to the beach.
- 5. Members and guests are asked to clean the picnic tables after use, and deposit waste in the trash barrels
- 6. May 1st to Nov 1st Dogs <u>will not</u> be allowed beyond the gate at the big beach. Dogs are not allowed on the little beach. Dogs are not allowed in the water in either beach. Dogs may walk the driveway to the day dock to board a boat or to swim in that area.
- 7. The area on either side of the dock at the big beach is designated for launching of boats.
- 8. The dock will be used only for pickup and discharge of passengers, leaving it free for others to use as soon as possible.
- 9. For reasons of safety, the dock will not be used for waterskiing take-off.
- 10. Glass containers should not be used in the beach areas. If you do use glass containers at the beach, please take them home with you.
- 11. No rough-housing on the rafts.
- 12. All group gatherings exceeding 15 people must have prior approval by the Ridgewood Association Secretary to avoid simultaneous, large-group gatherings. In consideration of other members, guests are asked to park outside the beach area. Following a large gathering, the host must provide for cleaning of the porta potty the morning of the next day or as soon as the service is available. A donation of \$25.00 prior to the outing is requested.
- 13. Fireworks are not allowed on any Ridgewood Association property.
- 14. Fires on the beach are allowed only under the following conditions:
 - A fire permit must be obtained by the member
 - Two Board members must be notified prior to 2pm the day of the fire
 - The fire must be in containers
 - An Association member must remain with the fire at all times until it is extinguished
 - A thorough clean-up must be done ASAP
