

Edward Bailey, Former Elkton Publisher, Dies

A former Elkton area newspaper publisher and printing shop owner, Edward Bailey, 47, died Wednesday in St. Petersburg, Florida, after suffering a heart attack.

He was born January 13, 1927.

Mr. Bailey was publisher of the Elkton Advance newspaper for several years and also operated a printing business in that community. He was also associated with the Huron Daily Tribune during that time in the printing department.

Mr. Bailey was operating a printing business in Florida at the time of his death.

Surviving are his wife, Sandra; four daughters, Mrs. Marsha Anderson, Grand Rapids, Mrs. Marlene Briggs, Bad Axe, Mrs. Margo Barry, Elkton, and Miss Michelle Bailey, also of Bad Axe; one grandchild, and four brothers, Maynard Bailey, Flint, Orville Bailey, Ludington, Harley Bailey, Minnesota, and Ellis Bailey, Harbor Springs.
