State Office Reprint Concerning C of M Evaluations

Important updates for Certificate of Merit Evaluations:

Evaluations will resume in late-May/early June, depending on advice from local governments in regard to the current COVID-19 pandemic. You and your students will receive a notification once their evaluations have been rescheduled.

The CM Council and State Organization are reviewing different options for this to take place. More details on the Evaluation procedures will be discussed with each branch or region in late April.

The required syllabus piece on the student's application must remain the same, but the remaining repertoire can be changed without penalty. Due to the ongoing pandemic and with the health and safety of students and their families in mind, all CM Convention 2020 Recitals will be canceled. Student who have already enrolled for the 2020 Convention will be refunded.
