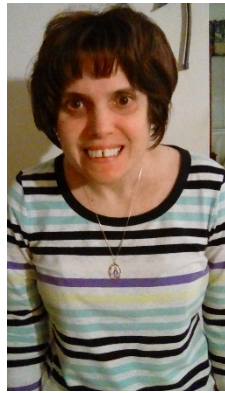

He strikes his breast with his right hand, saying: To us, also, your servants, who, though sinners, And, with hands extended, he continues: hope in your abundant mercies, graciously grant some share and fellowship with your holy Apostles and Martyrs: with John the Baptist, Stephen, (to be continued:) God Bless Fr. 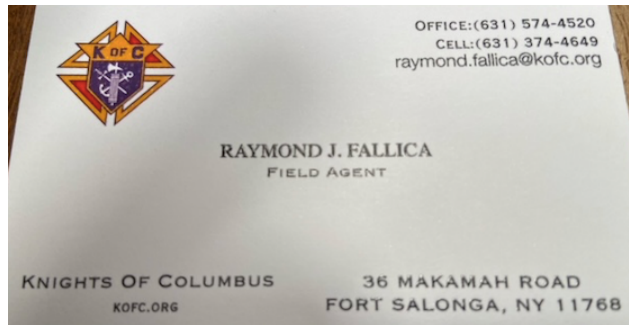
