Call to Order

President April Harper called the TBA Board meeting to order at 7:05 pm EDT via ZOOM. Also present:

Reading of the Minutes

The April 20, 2020, general meeting minutes were previously emailed to the Board. They were read by Barbara at the meeting. Denise motioned to approve. Ann seconded. Approval on vote.

Reports

No treasurer's report was requested.

2020 Convention: Ann reported responses from teachers after asking their opinions about proceeding or cancelling the convention. After discussion, Linda motioned to cancel. Barbara seconded. Approval on vote. The Board was reminded of the decision made at the April 20 meeting:

If the 2020 convention is cancelled, the Board should proceed with contract negotiations with the Alcoa Hilton for the 2021 convention, and with Pickwick Landing State Park for 2022. The Board will proceed.

New Business
