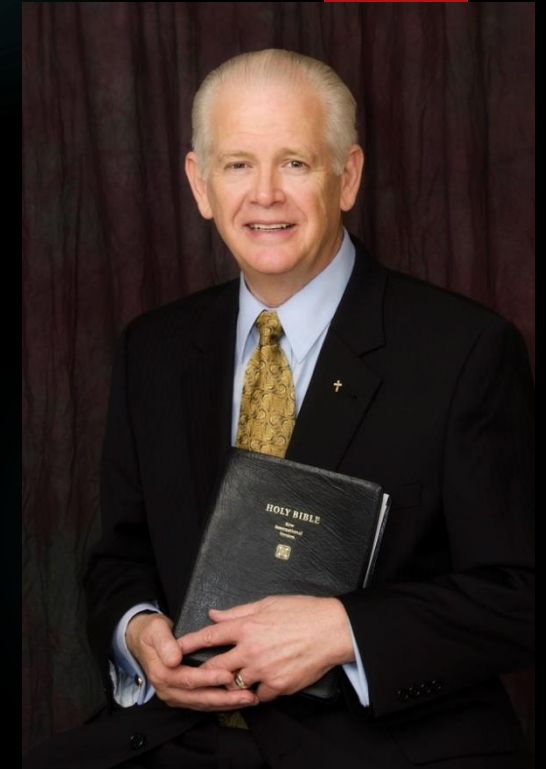

Sanctuary Services




For those attending services in the Sanctuary, in person, offering plates will not be passed, but will be accessible on a table in the foyer.


