2020 St. Patrick's Day Parade Rules and Regulations

Parade Date: Saturday, March 21, 2020
Step Off: 2:00 p.m. (line-up will begin at noon)
Assembly Point: City Island

Parade Route: Attached

Entry Fees:

High School Marching Band: **Free**

Non Profit Organizations/Clubs **Free**

Commercial Units—Business/Corporate Groups **\$100**

(Entry fees are waived for sponsored groups: military, honor guards, Irish dance groups, & bands & parade sponsors)

Parade Entries:

- There will be no stopping along the parade route. You may pause when announced, but may not stop at any time to perform.
- Each entry with a motor vehicle must certify being covered by liability insurance as provided by PA law and it must be operated by a driver with a valid driver's license. *(Please provide a copy with your registration forms)*
- If an entry has multiple vehicles, each vehicle must be listed on the registration form. Parade officials will be verifying the number of vehicles on Parade Day, if they are not listed on the registration form, they will not be permitted.
- Use of sound systems must be listed on registration form for adequate line of march placement.
- The use of firecrackers, noisemakers, blanks, etc., are not permitted.
- No unit may be higher than 16 feet in order to clear traffic lights and wires.
- All decorative materials should be fire retardant. The use of open flames on any entry is PROHIBITED.
- Participants on bicycles, scooters, skateboards, etc. must wear a helmet.
- **Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the parade assembly area or along the parade route.** Violators will be removed from the parade and your group may be denied participation in next year's parade.
- Solicitation of funds is prohibited.

Parade Entries with Animals:

- Participants must provide a means of clean-up.
- All dogs in the parade must be kept on leashes.
- Saddled animal entries must include a copy of their liability insurance declaration page with their registration form.

Distribution of items along the Parade Route:

- Tossing of items from vehicles is PROHIBITED. Throwing items from vehicles promotes children running into the middle of the parade entries and causes an unsafe environment. Distribution of items (such as candy or promo items) along the parade route will only be permitted *if items are handed out along the curb*. Please help us maintain a safe environment for everyone.

Conduct:

- All individuals participating in the parade are expected to perform courteously, in good taste, and with safety in mind at all times.
- The applicant is responsible for the conduct of all its participants and agrees to notify ALL participants within their entry of these rules and regulations.

Please Note:

- Completed/signed registration forms are your acceptance of all parade rules and regulations.
- Reminder! This is a forward moving parade. Participants may not stop to perform in front of the reviewing stand or along the parade route. You must keep moving.
