In addition to helping manage the technical assistance activities, David has provided education and outreach to utilities, state energy offices, and public utility commissions on overcoming barriers to CHP and adopting "best practices" policies. He has assisted utilities in several states examine options for designing incentives for CHP deployment and for calculating the energy savings from CHP projects. At ERC he also provides his skills and support for the Energy Efficiency Team that conducts energy efficiency analysis and modeling and designs and administers public sector and low income energy efficiency programs.
