## LET'S TALK ABOUT IT!

It's our last Scripture of the school year! These verses are a part of the same letter that King Solomon was writing to his son. This was his wise advice.

What do you imagine or picture when you hear this phrase, "drift off course"? Why do you think this happens sometimes? What are some causes? What are some effects?

Remember we said wisdom is simply knowing what's right and doing it. How can we "walk in wisdom"? What does this look and sound like in class? In our friendships? Why do you think King Solomon calls it a goal for life?

What is purpose? What does empower mean?

Purpose is the reason for which something exists/lives or is done, made or used. Empower means to "give power or authority to." How can "walking in wisdom" and "discovering your purpose" give you power and strength?

Read verse 22. How do you think this happens? Why do you think King Solomon advised his son with this?

When you read verse 23, what do you think of or picture in your mind? What do you think "living hope" is? What's the opposite of hope? How does this "living hope" guide you?

Read verse 26. What is confidence? What's the opposite of confidence? Can you think of a time when you felt you were in crisis or a serious bad time? How did you feel? What did you do? How can we make God our confidence? Why do you think as a daddy, King Solomon would encourage his son with this?
