SOCIAL DISTANCING MANDATE POLICY AT SAINT PAUL

Even though the mask mandate has been lifted by the Diocese, we are still required to maintain social distancing within our church. Thus, current policy only allows us a strict and limited seating capacity.

Unfortunately, once our capacity is met, and every chair is occupied we are required to close the doors and allow no one else to enter.

Therefore, we encourage you to arrive a little early to ensure you find seating.

This is not a pleasant thing to enforce, and hopefully it will not last much longer. Please be patient and realize that we are only doing what is required of us.

DISPENSATION

The dispensation for those good folks not able to meet their Sunday obligation has been lifted.

Dispensation continues only for those who are sick and severely disabled, restricted to their home or medical facility and unable to attend Mass.

The dispensation is also allowed for those who still hold a fear of COVID, but only if they are totally self-quarantined to their home and not going out into the public, e.g., dining out, driving, shopping, socializing, conducting business outside of church, etc.

If folks can move about publicly, they can also attend Mass.
