Approval of May 19, 2016 minutes: Motion by Boyd, supported by Rohde to approve minutes of May 19, 2016. All in favor.

New Business: Stacey Miller, Slade Road, Ironwood, MI addressed the board on a complaint filed against companies operated by Ruotsala and Tiziani. The chairman requested that the secretary read the complaint for the record. The complaint for excessive use of jake brakes, hauling, noise, dust, and operation beyond hours of operation as stated in Ordinance 50 was addressed. (Past 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 21, 2016, and Sunday, May 22, 2016.) Mr. Miller gave the board copies of time sheets and a copy of a letter from a resident who lived on the end of Maple Lane (Attached). The zoning administrator investigated the complaint and the matter has been resolved.

Old Business: Lynn commented on how pleased he was with the zoning administrator's performance and reports the board received from him. Motion by Boyd, seconded by Rohde to place the zoning administrator's logs on file. Motion carried.

Public Comment: (5 minute limit) Per Tiziani's request the 5 minute public comment time was lifted. Tiziani explained his business and said he had a variance to operate and haul out on Sunday. Boyd requested that any variances be included when the board approves the permits for pits. The chairman requested a copy of the variance to operate on Sunday to be brought to the board to put on file. Ruotsala discussed his business, dust control, and hours of operation. He asked for an explanation on burning and fireman's policy and why the sheriff was called when a burn ban was lifted.
