I chose this project because I was inspired by my daughter and son-in-law who at the last hour of their daughter's life "Dared to Dream" and gave the ultimate sacrifice which is their daughter's organs for another life. She saved four (4) other persons lives and one of those was a child her age who received her heart. Advent Health Orlando has performed more than 4,200 kidney transplants, placing them in the top 10% of transplant programs in the United States. Advent Health Liver Transplant Program began in 2007 and grew quickly as a response to local need. They have transplanted more than 700 liver patients and have maintained the highest liver patient survival rate in the Nation.

Since January of 2012, they have performed over 225 heart transplants and more than 90 lung transplants, the very first in Central Florida. The heart transplant program is now the 7th largest program in the United States. I encourage you to donate to the President's project this year and know that you can write a service report for your donation under Community Service because the donations help everyone, including veterans.

Please make sure to read the information from the School of Instruction trainer PNP Charlene Kee will have along with this book report. We can all benefit from this information.

"We are Family" is not just a slogan, it's who we are and if; for whatever reason, you need assistance, or have a question, don't be afraid to ask. All Officers including me are here to help you.
