Board Election Notice

There are three Board positions to be filled at the annual meeting, March 5, 2019

The nominating committee has submitted the names of Terry Bates, Langford, and Hector Mendoza to fill three vacancies, on the Board. In addition to names submitted by the nominating committee, credit union bylaws provide for nomination from the membership. A petition signed by at least 35 members may submit other names.

The deadline for filing a petition with the credit union Secretary is January 29, 2019. If petitions are received, resulting in more than one nominee for each position to be filled, ballots will be distributed to eligible voters attending the annual meeting, March 5, 2019.

Election shall then be determined by plurality vote. If no petitions are received and there is only one nominee for each position to be filled, those nominated shall be elected by general consent of acclamation. Nomination from the floor at the annual meeting shall not be permitted.
