Rules

Co-Sanctioning

Baileys Barrel Bonanza Open and associated Classes will co-sanction BRN4D, NBHA, CWP,

Co-sanction "eye-fees" will be collected from those riders desiring co-sanction points or qualifiers.

Race Entries

BBB Open and Associated Classes Pre Entries will open July 1, 2021 and must be paid in full and postmarked by August 7, 2021 **No late entries will be accepted**

***BBB August 19-20 Peewee Entries will open June 1, 2021 and must be paid in full and postmarked by July 1, 2021. June 1st to June 7th Entries are open to those that entered last year and wish to run this year. If you entered last year make sure you check the box on the entry form. No entries will be received after July 1, 2021. Peewee age is 10 years old or younger as of race date, Office staff may ask for proof of Age. Those who were entered and aged out in 2020 may still enter this race. Pee Wee entries are limited to 150.

Entries are mail in only and payment must accompany entry. Checks only. No Money Orders or postdated checks will be accepted.

Draw outs

Full refund with vet or Medical slip. Refund minus office fee for other draw outs up till Saturday August 7th. No Pen refunds after August 7th, you may sell your pen – Please fill out the form for camping, pens and time onlys. The office will keep a waiting list for pens.

Changes

Changes after Aug. 7th will require a \$10 change fee. 2nd Change fee and thereafter are \$20 each.

Dress Code

Saturday and Sunday races are Dress code required. Dress code is long sleeve western shirt and Hat/Helmet.

Race Categories

Open 5D: \$60 entry fee. This class is open to any rider. This class is capped at 500 riders.

<u>Youth 5D</u>: \$25 entry fee. This class is open to all persons 17 years of age or younger on January 1, 2021. (Roll Only)

Senior 5D: \$25 entry fee. Any time on or after their 45th Birthday. (Roll Only)

Novice 5D: \$25 entry fee. This class is the 6th D through the 10th D which uses the fastest time in the open to determine the divisions. This class is meant to be a true novice class. If your time is faster than the 6D you will be disqualified and receive no money. Your time will still be used to determine your average for awards.

Youth, Senior must enter open and roll their times.

<u>Peewee 10D</u>: \$25 entry fee per day. This class is open to all persons 10 years and under as of Race Day. Average awards are based on 2 day average. There is no day money or awards for Peewees. The PeeWee race will be ran August 19, 2021 3PM and August 20, 2021 at 9AM. <u>PEEWEES must choose between the PeeWee Class or Open/Youth/Novice classes. They cannot run both sets.</u>

<u>Lead lines</u> - \$25 entry fee per day. Lead line will run 1st and separately from other Peewee contestants. (Parent or helper that is on course with the horse and rider will be considered a lead line.) This is for safety of the Children. This is a Noncompetitive Class standard awards will be given.

Pee Wee 2 day average award Splits 1D, 2D= 1D+2 second, 3D=1D + 4 seconds, 4D =1D+6 seconds 5D + 8 seconds, 6D +10 seconds, 7D + 12 seconds, 8D + 14 seconds, 9D + 16 seconds, 10D + 18 seconds.

Proof of age may be requested for Peewee, Youth and Senior Classes

Men's Race 4D \$25 entry. Splits are ½ seconds

Office Charge: A \$25 office charge for the weekend \$15 a day.

<u>Time Runs</u>: \$5 per run pay at gate 1 minute maximum. Time runs Thursday at 9AM-2PM, Friday 1PM to 7PM. Reservations will be online. Spots not filled will be paid at the gate on a 1st come basis.

70% of entry fee payout, 1 place per 20 riders: OPEN 5D - \$2,500 added, Youth 5D - no added, senior 5D no added, Novice 5D no added.

Race Rules

The race will be run on a 70ft. X 90ft.course with a 30ft. score.

A barrel down will result in a no-time.

An off-course run will receive a no-time. Any dismount, voluntary or un-voluntary while on course will result in a no-time.

The decision to award a time, or to post a no-time rests with an appointed "Arena Official" or show management. The ruling will be final.

Re-runs may be granted for timer or show equipment failure, or interference as determined by the "Arena Official".

If a no-time situation occurs before the above-mentioned re-run reasons, the no-time will stand.

No re-runs will be granted for rider or equipment failure.

Re-runs can be ran immediately, or if the rider chooses, they may run just after a "big" rake. We will then do a quick clean-up rake and get back to our run order.

Poor sportsmanship or abuse of a horse will not be tolerated. Offenders may be warned, they may be asked to leave the facility at the discretion of show management and will forfeit all entries, stall, office and other fees paid.

Issues Not Covered

Any situation arising not covered by these rules will be addressed individually by the Arena Official and show management. The ruling will be final.

Awards

Riders must be present to receive their awards. If they are unable to attend the award ceremony they may designate a person to pick up their awards. They must fill out a form at the office.

Additional Information and Arena Rules

- 1. Fire lanes must be kept open at all times. (15 feet from all exterior fences)
- 2. Parking attendants will guide people where to park. If you park unguided you may be asked to move.
- 3. Self pens are allowed in designated area only and must be next to trailer with a maximum of 20x20 feet. There is a self-pen fee of \$10 for the weekend to pay for cleanup, garbage and Santi cans.
- 4. Quiet time is 10PM, no loud generators or parties after this time. Please respect your fellow campers.
- 5. Farm equipment and equipment storage areas are off limits to all.
- 6. Horses must remain on the premises.
- 7. The gravel road by arena is a private road and for residents only. No Horses Allowed.
- 8. No tying horses to fences, trees or connecting personal pens to fences.
- 9. Minors consuming alcohol is strictly prohibited. Minors observed using alcohol or visibly impaired may be asked to leave the facility.
- 10. Facility will open at 12noon Wednesday for arrivals.

- 11. **Absolutely** no shavings are allowed in the pens or self pens in the hay field. Clean up fee may be charged.
- 12. Dogs must be restrained at your trailers, no dogs allowed in vendor area or near the office area.
- 13. If you tie to your trailer overnight you will need to be in the far back field and gates will close at 10 pm. This is to keep your horses from getting out of the fields and onto the busy highway. No tying to trailers at night in the 2 front fields. Tying to trailers must be 10 feet from any tree trunk.
- 14. No pens or high lines within 10 feet of tree trunks.
- 15. Please no Cigarette Butts or Bottle caps on ground
