### 334/20 Minutes of previous meeting.

# 338/20 Bus shelter – Stourbridge Rd. Fairfield

The Committee agreed in principle to carry out repairs to the 'Green' bus shelter to include new panels and Perspex and would seek a quote for the work.

The Committee would also investigate the options for putting up a replacement bus shelter at the site although due to space constraints that would need co-operation from the adjacent landowner. **Action**: the clerk to seek costings and also ascertain the ownership of the adjacent field.

The Committee agreed a contribution of £750 towards the costs that the tenant wished to incur to improve the frontage of the premises. Such action would be enhancing site accessibility for the local community.
