As my daughter squeezed my hand she was also grinding my ring into the neighboring finger. She was getting stitches taken out but I think I was in more pain. How could a 110 lb girl have that strong of a grip? Whine though I might, I was still willing to let her inflict the pain if it would ease hers. Often, we wonder how God can let us go through pain if He is supposed to be all loving. "How could He let this happen?" rolls off our lips. Yet, through our own personal pain we loose sight of the fact that God is with us feeling as much or pain as we are.

Ironically, pain entered the world because when God said, (Genesis 1:26). "Let us make man in our image, in our likness." He also gave the "created image" a choice to follow their Creator. God wanted a creation that would love Him because they chose to, not because they had too. As a result of that choice, sin entered the world and pain, tears, disaster and death, have been a part of it every since.

At the point when God could have turned His back (Phil 2:5-8) "... Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death even death on a cross!
