





### By the Numbers:

58% (714) - Women reporting history of Domestic Violence Abuse

46% (573) - Women reporting history of Mental Health barriers

28% (348) - Women reporting history of Substance Abuse barriers

15% (189) - Women who received some sort of case management services while in shelter 3% (39) - Women with exits to Permanent Housing Destinations from shelter

5% (57) - Women with exits to remained thousing Destinations from shelle

46 Days - Average length of overall stay for women in shelter

22 Days - Average length of shelter stay episode for women in shelter
