These cases are handled at our office in Fort Collins. Arbitrators are paid a \$100.00 stipend for each case.

After filling out the application, you will be contacted by a representative from BBB to explain the training process. All training for the BBB Auto Line Program is free of charge, and is conducted by telephone and/or online.

Candidates who successfully complete the training will also be eligible to hear Binding Arbitration cases for your local BBB. Binding Arbitration is offered to consumers and businesses as a final means of resolving qualifying marketplace disputes and can be regarding a wide variety of issues.
