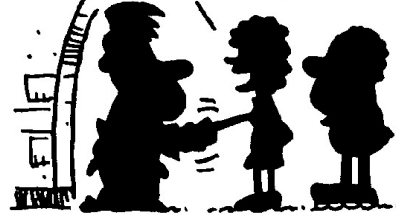
Live the Liturgy
