In accordance with a recent instruction issued by the Holy See, the Priest, along with any other lay distributors, will sprinkle ashes on the head of each person without saying anything and without imposing ashes on the forehead. The archdiocesan update also issued the reminder that ashes "may not be self imposed; they are always given by a minister," and the "wearing of ashes, while customary and laudable, is not an obligation of the faithful, so anyone who is fearful of becoming sick should not come forward, or even come to Mass on Ash Wednesday."
