## RESORT VILLAGE OF ECHO BAY

## **BYLAW NO. 4/04**

## A BYLAW TO ALLOW FOR THE SAFE, COURTEOUS AND RESPONSIBLE USE OF ATV'S WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF ECHO BAY.

The Council of the Resort Village of Echo Bay in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. (a) "All Terrain Vehicle (ATV)" means three (3) and four (4) wheelers
  - (b) "Highway" means a highway as defined in <u>The Highway Traffic Act</u> and includes a road, parkway, driveway, square or place designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area;
  - (c) "Public land" means Crown land or any land vested in the municipality, as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act;
- 2. ATV's will be allowed to operate within the corporate limits of the Resort Village of Echo Bay on highways or public land unless prohibited.
- 3. ATV's must not exceed 30 kph.
- 4. ATV usage will be subject to the provisions of <u>The All Terrain Vehicles Act</u> which Includes, but is not limited to:
  - A. Operator must have a valid driver's license
  - B. Operator must wear a helmet and eye protection
  - C. Operator must be able to provide proof of liability insurance coverage.
  - D. ATV must not carry more passengers than designated by manufacturer.
- 5. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalty imposed by Section 32 of <u>The All Terrain Vehicles Act.</u>
