He ran in a combination bit that L&W makes. I was very patient, and I built up his confidence. I called on him in the slot race, and the cards just all fell into place. I couldn't have asked for a better run!

I always keep an open mind, and I am very honest with myself on where I need to improve. I keep a very positive attitude, and I never give up. I also believe it is very important to be patient when dealing with young horses.

JOLENE MONTGOMERY

JL JAMAICAN ME RICH aka 'Richie' is an incredibly talented horse, and his owners, Dave and Lori Zabel, and I knew it was only a matter of time before he pulled it all together for the win! He had been getting better and better leading up to the Diamonds and Dirt, but had not yet had the perfect run. Small mistakes were keeping him out of the winner's circle. I was actually thinking about running him in the slot race so I took him to Bryan the weekend before for a little

warm-up run, but he got scared and stepped off of the second barrel so I backed down on the slot race. The only thing I did between that run and the weekend before was try to soften him up more on the left side, and keep him quiet. When I got to Bryan Monday evening Dr Mark DePaolo with Horse Hair Analysis did Chiropractic work and acupuncture on Richie. I knew as soon as I stepped on him after he was worked on that I should have put him in the slot. He felt amazing!

So in the first round of the futurity I eased him in to the first, and had a decent first barrel, which is his trickiest barrel because he runs super hard, and gets a little too round. His second barrel was super fast, so then I got a little too excited and smooched him and drove him down to the third, and subsequently got about a stride by it! He finished the first round with a placing 16.1. Kicking, driving, or smoothing is absolutely not necessary with Richie! So on Richie's second run, again I walked him to the front of the alley. eased him to the first, which was nice, and just tried to sit really still and help him a little the rest of the run, and he was flawless! I could not have asked for a smoother run! Finally, the run we had been waiting for!! In the finals, I did my best for a repeat performance of the second round, but it didn't quite happen. Again, I walked to the front of the alley and let him go, but this time he got in a little to the first. This had never happened on him before, so when I asked him to move over a little, he moved over A LOT! He is super sensitive, and was just doing what I asked him to, but it caused us to have a pretty wide first, and I kicked it on the way out. I thought it was down, but I heard the audience saying it was up right before the second, so I just tried to finish the run smoothly, and Richie did just that. With a flawed first barrel, he ran another 16.1 to be fast enough for the win!

I'm pretty sure I'm in love with the JL Dash Ta Heaven's, same as I was him! They are extremely talented, athletic, fast, and sensitive. Richie took a lot of riding and training, just like his Daddy, and I think a lot of them do take a little more time and patience than some colts, but it's worth the wait!

Richie is about 16 hands tall, but it's all legs! He's really not big anywhere else. And he's like an overgrown puppy--always has to have his nose on you or something else! We had Dr Pepper bottles hanging by hay string tied all over his stall at the Diamonds and Dirt to keep him occupied. I ride him in a simple junior cowhorse,

and rope nose tie down. As far as tuning, I just try to keep him relaxed, do a lot of pasture riding, and make sure he gets his turn-out time. On the barrels I really just trot and lope him through at home, and make him do the pattern almost completely on his own, without me telling him to turn.

We bought Richie as a two-year-old from Jud Little's production sale. Dave and Lori and I had picked out a few different colts in the sale book, and I went to check them out. I wouldn't normally have picked out a huge two year old gelding, but he rode great, and was sooooo classy looking! He was broke and riding quietly, but after the sale I took him straight to Brice Manning (who breaks a lot of my colts) until after the BFA so he would be riding perfect and ready to start on the barrels as soon as I got him. I picked him up and started training right after the BFA, just before he turned 3. Brice had done an excellent job having him ready, but he told me, and I could feel for myself, that it was going to take a lot of time, and it sure did!

The journey to becoming a barrel horse trainer is just that, a journey! It's like a dirt road through the mountains: it's a slippery slope when it's raining, a dusty trail when it's not, and its always slow and bumpy! If you want to be a barrel horse trainer, you can pretty much count on 5 to 10 years of blood, sweat, and tears to get there. You have to really, really want it. Now, I'm not trying to scare anyone away; it makes it that much more gratifying when you do achieve success!

My journey started as a kid going to weekend barrel races with the family and melded into jumping lessons, galloping at the racetrack, learning how to break colts without getting hurt, and a move to Texas by myself at 19. I worked for a quarter horse race trainer in Mineral Wells, and a cutter in Weatherford, and broke several more on my own before moving back to Ohio for a couple years to work for Troy Crumrine. Back in Ohio I had a place rented and started training on my own for the first time. After a couple of winters freezing my tail off, I landed the job at the Jud Little Ranch, where I was

finally able to learn how to really get a GOOD barrel horse trained! So I guess the biggest thing I would tell young, aspiring trainers, is to never let a rock go unturned. If there is a chance of an opportunity, you have to go for it. Don't let your pride, or fear of rejection stop you. Beg for a chance to ride a good one, and don't be afraid to mess up. That's going to happen! And then you just have to pick yourself up and try again!

Staying focused has never really been a problem for me. A bigger problem for me is figuring out how to un-focus so to speak. When you have trained these colts from day one, you don't really have to think hard about how to ride each one; it pretty much just comes to you when you step on them to warm up--like muscle memory, I guess. I don't know if I can speak for anyone else, but I have a harder time just letting the run happen,

and reacting to the colt, than trying to focus for the run. You cannot predict and plan for what a four year old is going to do. You can try to picture the perfect run in your head, and that helps, but you have to go in there playing offense, not defense. I try to ride like everything is going to go perfectly smooth, and only react when it doesn't (which is 90% of the time, btw).
