## Comfort Care for Babies Born with Life Limiting Conditions and Their Families.

Like all parents, you want your baby's life to be filled with love. Perinatal palliative care is comfort care for when you have learned that your baby's life may be much shorter than expected. Before learning that your baby's life may be short, you had plans for what you wanted to do before, during and after your baby's birth. You can still make plans and the Perinatal Palliative Care Team is available to help you. There is no cost for meeting with this team.

Our Perinatal Palliative Care Team is dedicated to supporting your family during this trying time by helping you to plan for your baby's care before birth and after.

### The Team Includes:

- Nurses who care for the mom and baby (labor and delivery nurse)
- Nurses who care for the baby (neonatal intensive care nurse)
- Doctor who care for the baby (neonatologist)
- Social Worker
- Chaplain or your clergy if desired
- Others whom you choose

### How Can the Perinatal Palliative Care Help Me, My Baby and Family?

You and whomever you choose, can meet with the Perinatal Palliative Care Team prior to your baby's birth. The team can help you create a personal birthing care plan and answer questions.

### Frequently Asked Questions from Parents:

- Can we see our baby?
- Can we name our baby?
- Can we hold our baby?
- Can we give care to our baby?
- Can our baby be baptized or blessed?
- Can we take pictures of our baby?
- Can our friends and family be with us?
- How long can we be with our baby?

### Perinatal Palliative Care Also Helps Parents with These Goals:

- Finding meaning in your baby's short life
- Being sure that your baby is not in pain
- Taking your baby home if possible
- Having special memories of your baby
