

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

TOWN OF KREMMLING
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
March 15, 2017

The Board of Trustees, for the Town of Kremmling, met in the boardroom located at 200 Eagle Avenue. Mayor Pro-Tem Scott Crandall called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Trustees present: Gina Schroeder, Jason Wikberg, Wes Howell, Guy Bakke, and Grace Bohall. Staff present: Town Manager Mark Campbell, Police Chief Scott Spade, Public Works Director Jason Bock and Town Clerk Rhonda Shearer.

SCHROEDER MOVED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES. HOWELL SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

HOWELL MOVED TO APPROVE THE EXPENDITURES FROM MARCH 2, 2017 THROUGH MARCH 15, 2017 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$199,113.11. SCHROEDER SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

BAKKE MOVED TO APPROVE THE AGENDA. SCHROEDER SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

There were no citizen comments.

The Grand County Weed Advisory Board would like a member from Kremmling on their board. Manager Campbell stated that he would like Jason Bock to be our member, and Manager Campbell will be the alternative.

TRUSTEE BAKKE MADE THE MOTION. SCHROEDER SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

The Mayor was absent. Manager Campbell noted that Mayor Clark had nominated Manager Campbell to be on the Local Government Limited Gaming Impact Advisory Committee. Manager Campbell would like approval for Mayor Clark to sign for him to be on the ballot, for him to be on that committee.

WIKBERG MADE THE MOTION. HOWELL SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

The Police Chief reported:

- There has been a request made for a four way stop at the intersection of Eagle Avenue and Fourth Street. As time allows, the public works crew will get the additional stop signs installed.
- There is a possibility in the future, of a shared employee between the school district and the town. During school, the employee would be a resource officer, and then would work as a police officer when school isn't in session.


The Public Works Director reported:
