Trumpets cover 1/5 of Revelation (8-11) or 1/3 (8-14[15])

Revelation is the Fifth Gospel

Revelation 1:1

Beast does not show up until Revelation 11

Revelation 1:4-20

Three Principles of Prophecy

- 1. Prophecy reveals God's love (1 John 4:8)
- 2. Begins in the time of the prophet
- 3. Written in symbolic language

Jesus is in the midst of the Churches! Jesus is with us!

7 Seals = Lamb Slain = Crucifixion

7 Trumpets = Incense = Intercession

1 Corinthians 15:1-4

REVELATION's Symbols reveal the Gospel.

4 Views of Interpretation

- Preterist everything is in the past.
- <u>Futurist</u> everything is in the future.
- <u>Idealist</u> only truths for right now, truth changes for time and circumstances. There is a good for me and there is good for you.
- <u>Historicist</u> Truth in each; truth in the past, truth in the present and truth in the future.

REVELATION has 70 references to the SANCTUARY. To understand Revelation we need to understand the Sanctuary.
