

ROAD ATLANTA: Corvette is the hottest team in the WeatherTech series right now with a four-race win streak going into the Sept. 4-6 Road Atlanta race. They started second and third in class and, as always, relied on execution and minimizing mistakes while capitalizing on those of others. Corvette Racing has won 10 times at Road Atlanta and this weekend, Oliver Gavin and Tommy Milner in the No. 4 Corvette completed a stellar comeback to finish as class runner-up, from nearly a lap down in the six-hour endurance race. This advanced them to second place in the GTLM Drivers' Championship standings.



Antonio Garcia and Jordan Taylor finished fifth in the No. 3 Corvette to retain their lead in the Drivers' Championship.

At **MID-OHIO** the ongoing fight between BMW and Corvette continued over the Sept. 26/27 weekend. Porsche had cancelled out due to Covid striking down their drivers at Le Mans the weekend prior. Jordan and

Antonio in the No. 3 managed to make it five wins here, dominating the race from flag to flag. Oliver Gavin and Tommy Milner placed second in the No. 4 Corvette C8.R to remain second in GTLM points.  proxy form is available (attached) for <u>same membership partners</u> who
 are unable to attend. If required, please print and complete. One
 member from the same membership must attend and bring the
 completed proxy form.
- Voting date will be Wednesday, October 14th, 2020 from 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm. No ballots will be accepted after 7:30 pm.
- The voting will take place near our General Meeting location, Sabina's Casual Dining & Pub, 1755 Pickering Parkway, Pickering. A drive-thru location will be set up in the south parking lot closest to the 401. Look for the tables and parked Corvettes. Canopies will be set up if the weather is inclement. Roxanne Chiusolo, Susanne Ralph, and Sue Woodland will be at this location administering the process.

As always, Sabina's will be available for anyone wishing to order dinner, however, the boardroom will not be available. Members are encouraged to vote upon arrival then socialize afterwards if they choose to do so.

Ballots will be counted by Roxanne Chiusolo, Susanne Ralph and Sue Woodland immediately after the 7:30 pm deadline. The successful candidates will be announced in an email the following day (October 15^{th}).


Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the formal Induction Banquet has been postponed until 2021 and will take place during the Michelin Bash in April.

- ➤ **Assembly Plant** update from Plant Manager Kai Spande (*sorry, no plant tours just yet!*): build restrictions (e.g. certain convertible parts take more time, therefore coupe and convertibles are not built back-to-back); Plant doesn't build in colour batches; explanation of supply capacity; discussion of quality hold/checks; 1.75 millionth Vette produced in August, being raffled this weekend. Two new exterior colours for 2021 were shown (Silver Flare Metallic replaced Blade Silver; and Red Mist Tint Cost replaces Long Beach Red).
- Hall of Fame Inductees participated in a Q&A;
- Corvette Production Team offered a detailed slide presentation and spoke about what's new for 2021.
