Letter from the Author

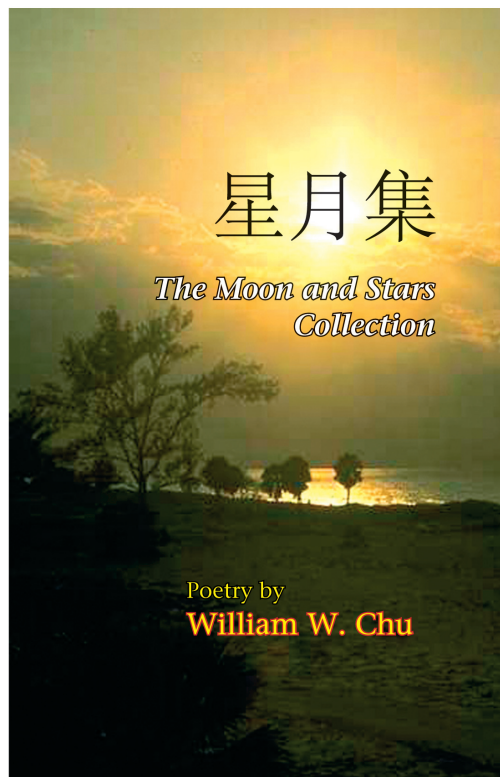
