Monthly Meeting Minutes

August 14, 2017

1. Call to Order- Wesley Ball called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. at the Goliad County Groundwater Conservation District Office. A prayer was led by Ms. Norrell.

Public Comment- No public comment.
2. Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Water Wells for the City of Kennedy in the Evangeline Aquifer. - GCGCD heard public comment regarding and had discussion regarding the proposed water wells for the City of Kenedy in the Evangeline Aquifer.
Mr. Korth made a motion to send Evergreen Underground Water Conservation District a letter requesting:
 1. GCGCD be provided professional hydrologic data showing the impact of this proposed well field on the Desired Future Conditions in Goliad County approved by resolution by GMA-15 members.
 2. GCGCD be provided with a comprehensive test plan for the requested test well.
 3. GCGCD be provided with the results of the test well.
 4. GCGCD be kept informed of the testing schedule so that GCGCD can install and monitor impact on household and livestock wells in Goliad County.
 5. GCGCD be provided hydrological data from Wet Rock, The City of Kenedy.
 6. GCGCD request a joint study with EUWCD.
 7. GCGCD will provide to EUWCD results of the observations in Goliad County.Ms. Cook seconded.
Mr. Dohmann made a motion to amend the motion to add GCGCD request for any type of mitigation that EUWCD would consider. Mr. Korth seconded the amendment and the motion passed 7-0.
No further discussion was made. The amended motion passed 7-0.
Ms. Cook made a motion to send the City of Kenedy an Open Records Request. Ms. Smith seconded and the motion passed 7-0.
No father public comment was made.
3. Adjourn – Mr. Korth made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Smith seconded and the motion passed 7-0.
