THE SUNDAY OF THE LEPER

Second week of Great Lent- Cleansing of the Leper

A reading from the letter of Saint Paul to the Romans (Rom 6\12-23)

BROTHERS and SISTERS

Therefore, Sin must not weigh over your mortal bodies so that you obey their desires. And do not present the parts of your bodies to sin as weapons for wickedness, but present yourselves to God as raised from the dead to life, and the parts of your bodies to God as weapons for righteousness. For sin is not to have any power over you, since you are not under the Law but under grace. What then? Shall we sin because we are not under the Law but under the grace? Of course not! Do you not know that if you present yourselves, to someone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one you obeys, either of sin which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to righteousness? But thanks be to God that, although you were once slaves of sin, you have become obedient from the heart to the pattern of teaching to which you were entrusted. Freed from sin, you have become slaves of righteousness. I am speaking in human terms because of the weakness of your nature. For Just as you presented the parts of your bodies as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness for lawlessness, so now present them as slaves to righteousness for sanctification.

For when you were slaves of sin, you were free from righteousness. But what prophet did you get then from the things

of which you are ashamed? For the end of those things is death. But now that you have been freed from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit that you have leads to sanctification and its end is eternal life. for the wages of sin is death but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. **Praise be to God Always!**


