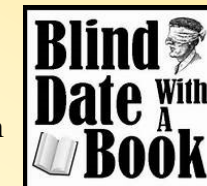

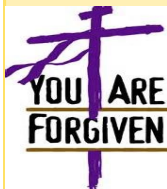
School, any morning of the week. If you are interested, we are seeking people who could be called in from time to time. -from approximately 7:50-9:20, working alongside one other volunteer to
