

2016 ADF AIRWAYS 737-800 NEXT GENERATION JET CHECKOUT

ADF Airways, an FAA approved Part 141 Flight Academy with over 25 years of experience, is offering a 737-800NG Jet Checkout. Using a state of the art simulator, the 737-800NG simulator program enhances CRM and strengthens crew cockpit skills with 16 hours in the simulator. Established in 1986 and located at the Kendall-Tamiami Executive Airport (TMB) in Miami, Florida; ADF is one of Miami's premier flight schools. They are approved by the Department of Veterans Affairs and also have Part 61 training. Assistance is also available for foreign students desiring FAA ratings with their student visas.

SCHOLARSHIP: FAA recognized 737-800NG Jet Checkout. In order to succeed in the modern cockpit, today's pilots must know more than just the basic requirements for a commercial pilot certificate. They must be knowledgeable of advanced systems and flight techniques, able to function in a two person cockpit, and capable of understanding and properly reacting to changing events on the ground and in the air. After completing this course you will have the required skills and knowledge to succeed at your airline training or interview.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any woman with at least an instrument pilot certificate and at least 50 hours VFR or IFR, post- Instrument certificate flight or simulator hours, to include approaches and holding patterns. They must be a resident of Florida or currently enrolled in an aviation training program in Florida. Prior to application, the Commercial certificate written exam must be completed.

SELECTION CRITERIA: The recipient of the scholarship will be selected by a committee consisting of judges active in aviation. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final. If no qualified applicant applies, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to withhold the scholarship.

Applications are judged on their:

- Desire to pursue a career in aviation.
- Ability to be an ambassador representing women in aviation.
- Likelihood of success at reaching their goals.
- Neatness and completeness of the application package.

There will be a conference call interview with applicants and the FL Goldcoast Chapter Scholarship Selection Committee to select the most qualified candidate from the finalists.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS: Write a letter describing your education, aviation training and experience, aviation (and non –aviation) organization involvement, and employment and/or educational history. List any activities in which you participate.

Include a statement of your educational purpose and/or aviation goals. Tell us about yourself, your goals and why you chose aviation, including special qualifications you may have.

If you are chosen to receive this scholarship, you will be responsible for your own transportation and accommodations (room and board) during the two week course. Please detail how you will obtain the funds to pay for or provide this during the two weeks simulator training.

Provide two letters of recommendation on the form provided— one from your instrument instructor and one from an employer, instructor or other appropriate person. Include copies of your FAA certificates, ratings, last two pages of your logbook and other pertinent documents. **Complete the two-page application.**

DISBURSEMENTS: Upon Selection for this scholarship, It is your responsibility to schedule times and dates of training with ADF Airways directly to be completed within six months of receipt of scholarship. Progress reports to the Scholarship Committee are required every 60 (sixty) days and weekly during the two week simulator training course. Submittals may be made by email or regular US Postal Service mail.

The school must be booked and completed by December 1st of the following year.
