In Brazil the headmaster at each school is required to provide religious education as part of his curriculum. Some headmasters invite evangelical Christians to teach the Bible as unpaid volunteers. That is what Tiana, Uries, and Rosemary do, when we are not caught in a pandemic, each in different schools, teaching the Bible to children, using materials provided by Child Evangelism Fellowship. But now in this pandemic they have found alternative opportunities to teach.

How to Pray:

1. Tiana has decided to spend some time up the Amazon, since the pandemic has closed access to the schools. She has expressed great enthusiasm for this venture and visit to a missionary she has known a long time. She plans to make this long, slow journey starting Nov. 24 and returning Jan. 11, 2021. Her son, Kaleo who is 18 or 19 by now, will be going with her. Destination: Alto Solimões Amazonas in the city of Atalaia do Norte. Pray for Tiana as she prepares lessons to teach women, for safe travels and that they will be a blessing to her missionary friend and all they meet.
2. Uries writes: "I want to thank God for everything He has done for us in these days and months, as our God has taken care of us by giving us protection. We can overcome everything with our faith." Schools have not yet resumed classes, but God has opened doors in different places. Uries has been teaching in a local church, and holding classes under a tree. His name was: CLÁUDIO HENRIQUE; he was 18 years old with the mind of a little child. His mother, Francisca, is suffering a lot. I am waiting for the return of classes so that I can pay her a visit. I ask you to please pray for her for comfort, and for me so that I have wisdom from above and know how to help her in some way. We look forward to the day schools open and we can again teach the Bible to the school children."
