**The Spanish Flu of 1918** with speaker Brian Armstrong, author and historian of local history. Mr. Armstrong also is the Vice President, Central Region, for the League of Historical Societies as well as President of the South River Historical and Preservation Society.

Between 1918-1920, this global specter killed an estimated 50-100 million people worldwide including 675,000 Americans.
