

MICHAEL LEOPOLD RENN

1914 - 1999

Michael L. Renn retired Elkton area farmer died Friday morning, June 11, at the Huron County Medical Care Facility.

He was born April 3, 1914 in Oliver Twp. at the home of his parents, the late Michael and Caroline (Lebreacht) Renn.

On April 29, 1939, he was united in marriage to Mildred Heck at Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, Elkton. She preceded him in death, May 8, 1998.

Mike farmed the family farm in Oliver Twp. all his working life, retiring in 1972. He was a member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, Elkton and served as the first president of its council for 21 years. He was past chairman of Production Credit of Sandusky serving on the board 24 years. Was president of the Elkton Senior Citizens 10 years, served on the Community Mental Health Board and the Council on Aging for ten years and was on the board of the Michigan Milk Producers Assn. 23 years.

Surviving are his son, Terry (Joanne) Renn of Oliver Twp; his daughter, Diane (James) Burleson of Elkton; four grandchildren, Paul Renn of Elkton, Janet (Michael) Devroye of Pigeon, Dean (Annette) Renn of Pigeon and Keri Fisher of Midland; three brothers, Karl (Irene) Renn of Lincoln Park, Fred (Olga) Renn of Pigeon and Harry (Marilyn) Renn of Elkton; four sisters, Wanda Smith, Clara Reid, Lena Fietzer and Ida Mae (Irvin) Thompson all of Pigeon.

Preceding him in death were a son, Randall in 1964, his sister, Sophia Metzger and his brother, Leonard Renn.
