RESOLUTION No. 9-17

ADOPTING A RULE LIMITING THE WEIGHT FOR
USE OF PUBLIC RAMP OWNED AND MAINTAINED BY PORT

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 53.08.220, a port district may formulate needful regulations for the use of any properties or facilities owned or operated by the Port of Manchester, and such needful regulations may be adopted through ordinance, resolution, or mutual agreement with the Kitsap Sheriff's Office, and

WHEREAS, The Port of Manchester has deemed it appropriate to adopt a rule or regulation regarding the weight limits for users of the public ramp owned and maintained by the Port for purposes of health, safety and public welfare,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Port of Manchester that:

No vehicle, trailer, vessel and equipment with a combined weight in excess of 30,000 pounds (15 tons) shall be allowed to use the public ramp owned and maintained by the Port for the use of its lawful users.

Any violation of this rule shall subject the violator to a fine as authorized by law and to any and all other sanctions as authorized by law.

ADOPTED, by the Port of Manchester Commissioners at a regular open public meeting thereof held this 14th day of September, 2017.
