His strong Catholic faith was the most important aspect of his life, and he was dedicated to strengthening the local attitude towards Catholic education.

His desire that Catholic Education be available for families who desired so led to his giving towards the Maurice Graham Scholarship. A scholarship has been established in Mr. Graham's honor to support students from the villages of Ludlow, Gifford, Penfeld, Thomasboro, Dewey, Fisher, Flatville, and Rantoul that are supporting members of the Catholic Parish(es) and schools that serve those communities and are attending the High School of Saint Thomas More.

The STM community is grateful for Mr. Graham's strong and committed belief in the legacy of a Catholic high school in Champaign.

For students to be eligible, they must:

- Be able to demonstrate that they are an active member of one of the following parishes: St. Malachy, Rantoul; St. Elizabeth, Thomasboro, or St. Lawrence, Penfield
- OR have attended St. Malachy School, Rantoul
- Each student receives at least \$500 per school year if they meet the eligibility requirements
