MINUTES JULY 15, 2021

MINUTES

A motion was made by Nancy, seconded by Wanda to approve the minutes of June 17, 2021. The motion was unanimously approved.

COMMUNICATIONS

Wanda read a letter from the Kansas Department of Revenue that discussed our participation in BPW Square Fair. The letter discussed whether or not our group needed to pay sales tax. CURATOR'S REPORT

OLD BUSINESS

At the last meeting, discussion was held on the possibility of finding posters for Cornstock, the Anderson County Fair and the Lake Garnett Car Races. Wanda explained that Joyce had talked to Susan Wettstein who has some of these posters. Kristie Kinney, former President of the Anderson County Historical Society, told Joyce that there were fair posters in the library of the museum.
