She has also served as a cooperating teacher for countless student interns from Meredith College and was a mentor for beginning teachers in the Wake County Public School System in Raleigh, NC. Prior to her work in the preschool setting, she worked as a teacher of the deaf and hard of hearing at the upper elementary and high school levels. She retired from Wake County Public Schools in 2018. During the final five years, she worked as a Preschool Coordinating Teacher, supporting preschool Special Education and Title I teachers. Currently, she works as a Conscious Discipline Certified Instructor, working with parents and teachers all over the country, and as a Life Coach for parents and teachers.
