

DOCTOR MORRISON PASSES AWAY AFTER LONG ILLNESS

Was Well Known: Huron County
Physician For Many Years.

William Thomas Morrison was born in Lamberton County, Ont., Aug. 18, 1865. He spent his boyhood days in the vicinity of his birth and completed his common school education at Strathroy. In 1890 he entered the Bellvue Training School for Male Nurses, of New York City, and graduated from that institution in 1892. From Bellvue he entered the Detroit College of Medicine and graduated in 1896:

After receiving his license as a physician he practiced in New Haven for a short time, coming to Bay Port forty years ago where he practiced for about three years. From Bay Port he went to Midland to remain six years, then coming to Pigeon in 1903 where he continued his practice until 1918 when he located in Albion. He returned to Pigeon in 1927.

Doctor Morrison passed away at 3:30 last Sunday afternoon following an illness of two years. It was only the last year that he refused to continue his practice. He was aware of his physical condition and patiently awaited the end.
