*McCain Walls* are quick and easy to install with the use of minimal tools. In some instances, job sites might require additional tools. To facilitate the installation process, we've put together a list of recommended tools to have on hand before starting the install.

To further simplify the installation process, here are a few proven tips to follow before building your *McCain Walls*.

- ① Ensure recommended tools are readily available on the job site.
- ② Read the basic installation guide and view the install video available on the website.
- ③ Become familiar with wall components and sort them.

### REQUIRED TOOLS LIST

We recommend the following basic tools:

- ☐ Chalk line or laser sight
- ☐ Impact driver with 5/16" bit 12"
- ☐ Ladder
- ☐ Level
- ☐ Miter saw with a non-ferrous blade
- ☐ Skill saw with a non-ferrous blade
- ☐ Tape: double-sided, duct, vinyl
- ☐ Tape measure
- ☐ Tin shears

Additional tools to consider having available:

- ☐ 4" - 6" box cutter, if insulation is used
- ☐ 4-wheel cart (recommended cart dimensions: 5' x 30")
- ☐ Face shield
- ☐ Philips screwdriver
- ☐ Safety glasses
- ☐ Saw horses
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Speed square
- ☐ Tool belt
- ☐ Vise grip C-clamps
