McCain Walls are quick and easy to install with the use of minimal tools. In some instances, job sites might require additional tools. To facilitate the installation process, we've put together a list of recommended tools to have on hand before starting the install.

To further simplify the installation process, here are a few proven tips to follow before building your *McCain Walls*.

- Ensure recommended tools are readily available on the job site.
- Read the basic installation guide and view the install video available on the website.
- Become familiar with wall components and sort them.

We recommend the following basic tools:

- ☐ Chalk line or laser sight
- ☐ Impact driver with 5/16" bit 12"
- ☐ Ladder
- Level
- ☐ Miter saw with a non-ferrous blade
- ☐ Skill saw with a non-ferrous blade
- ☐ Tape: double-sided, duct, vinyl
- ☐ Tape measure
- ☐ Tin shears

Additional tools to consider having available:

- \square 4"- 6" box cutter, if insulation is used
- 4-wheel cart (recommended cart dimensions: 5' x 30")
- ☐ Face shield
- ☐ Philips screwdriver
- ☐ Safety glasses
- ☐ Saw horses
- Scissors
- ☐ Speed square
- ☐ Tool belt
- ☐ Vise grip C-clamps
