

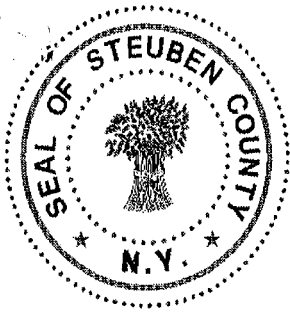

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- Sales/transfers are processed and reviewed regularly as they come in from the county.
- Exemption renewals continue to be submitted and processed. The senior citizen exemption renewals processed for 2021 have been returned to the 2020 income as directed by the Governor.
- Busy with phone calls regarding star and explaining the difference between the exemption program and the credit program. I have attached a notice our County RPT Director has posted on the county website. I have copies of this letter for the public to take hanging on the bulletin board in the vestibule. Also, the assessment page of the town website has been directing people to the star resource center of the state website for those that want to understand more about the credit program and the possible increase in savings each year that the program offers.
- Received annual continuing education status report from NYS. Required credits are met for 2020/2021 and 2021/2022. The association has been holding numerous classes on beneficial topics.
- 1/13 attended one-day seminar with NYSAA via Webex on 'Monitoring & Maintaining Equity in the Interim Years.' The instructor was excellent and the content extremely useful.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING CHANGES TO THE STAR EXEMPTION

As a result of New York State legislation passed in 2019, the STAR *exemption* savings amounts will no longer increase. The amount saved on your school tax bill in 2019 will remain the same going forward. This applies to both BASIC STAR and ENHANCED STAR.

New York State is encouraging property owners currently receiving the STAR exemption to switch to the STAR credit. If a property owner decides to switch to the STAR credit, they will receive a check from NYS DTF instead of a reduction on their school tax bill.

The STAR credit benefit may increase by up to 2% each year as school budgets and tax rates increase but the STAR exemption benefit will not change.

In order to maximize your STAR benefit you may need to change to receive your STAR benefit in check form. The register for the STAR benefit in check form, have the following information available and follow the instructions

- 2020 School Tax Bill
- Social Security numbers for all property owners
- Birthdates of all property owners
- 2019 Income tax statement (1040 or 1099)
- Legal name of trust, if applicable

#### Instructions for registering to receive your STAR benefit in the form of a check:

1. You will be prompted to enter the numbers for the security code shown on the screen then click continue. Scroll down and click "Make the Switch"
2. Answer the question "Is the property part of a mobile home park or co-op building?" Then click "No" for "Do you have a property key?" then click the drop-down arrow and choose the County. Click next drop-down arrow and choose City or town in which property is located. Click Continue.
3. Complete property owner name and property location information and click Search.
4. Scroll down, click on your property, click the circle to select your property then click Continue.
5. Finish answering all questions (scroll down to make sure all questions have been answered)
6. Once all questions have been answered, click Submit.
7. Be sure to print and save your confirmation for future reference.

### Consultations Held

I asked the Judges to dismiss all pending cases from last year and anything they have found since they have taken office. I have only 3 cases that I will have pending at this point. With the new Justices in place I am in hopes to have a better set of grounds when attending court.

This office ended 2020 with 36 building permit.

This office ended the year with 20 violation notices, with all notices and court appearance given more time to remedy, and that's where they ended up, no fines.

Issued the first violation notice for 2021 to 3545 Potter Hill Rd., Thomas Years for the accumulation of house hold garbage in a utility trailer being stored on the property, the neighbors did call to file a complaint.

The barn at 5 Wayland St. caught fire and part of the apartment to the back of the house. They had a crew come in and remove the remains of the debris, we did secure a building permit and there was no fee as long as the remains get removed.

I received a complaint about someone using a 5 gallon bucket for facilities and then dumping it out a second story window onto the ground, I had the Police Dept. deliver a 24hr. notice to comply and to clean it up, and the Chief called me to assure it got delivered.

This office has issued a cease and desist order to 10600 State Rte. 371 for accumulation of unregistered vehicles and stripping and dismantling of same.

The remains of the burned barn have been removed from 5 Wayland St. and they are intending on rebuilding the garage. Permit application has been secured.

The owner of 15 Main St. is in County Jail, I will be reissuing notices about the exterior of the buildings and the storage of unregistered vehicles on the property as soon as he gets out.

The windmill project is setting up temporary housing on Lent Hill Rd. during the time they are doing work on the windmills. Applications are being secured for permits to install the manufactured homes on a temporary basis.

Thomas Years did get a dumpster for the garbage being kept on a utility trailer for all to see. I am monitoring the location at 3545 Potter Hill Rd.

The library will be installing cold storage shed to keep chairs and table in, and whatever else they need to store, no permit required do to the size of the shed.

I received a complaint about trees being cut at 15 Beecher St. I called the owner and informed him they can't clear cut in the flood district, I turned it over to the DEC for further investigation.

I have not heard from the owners of 10331 Ryan Hollow Rd. after the house caught fire, I am monitoring the site and permits will be issued for removing burned structure and to build a new house if their intentions.
