SOME OF THE TOUR STOPS

National Parts Depot—Serving the hobby for over 40 years, NPD provides restoration parts for hundreds of collector car models and has massive fulfillment centers in Florida, North Carolina, Michigan and California. They are known for keeping massive inventory so all parts they offer can be delivered fast. The company's home office in Ocala includes a world-class car collection with over 200 vehicles. We will visit this collection.

Two Tales Elephant Ranch—Have you ever seen an elephant up close and personal? If not, here's your chance! Two Tails Ranch is the only privately owned elephant facility of its kind. The ranch was built to board both Asian and African elephants needing temporary or permanent housing, regardless of health or dispositions. Over 250 elephants have passed through the gates of the ranch for a variety of reasons. Some stayed temporarily while their own exhibits were being remodeled or built. Others stayed for retirement, medical needs, behavior problems or even in emergencies after hurricanes destroyed their zoos. The ranch also includes other animals including zebras, birds, and turtles. During the tour you will not only learn about elephants, but also get a chance to ride and feed them!
