VOTING INFORMATION

WHERE CAN I CAST MY BALLOT IN PERSON?

Please Vote in person! This is the absolute safest way to vote.

On the back of your Mail-In Ballot will be an address where you can **physically walk in** to a Consolidated (local polling place) locations, and cast your ballot. There will only be 235 such locations this year.

Consolidated location will be open **October 31st through Nov. 2nd** from 8 am to 5 pm.

On **Election Day**, Nov 3rd the hours will be 7 am to 8 pm.

Take your mail-in ballot AND its envelope with you. You will be asked to surrender the Mail-in ballot. (You can't use your ballot as a guide because it must be surrendered first. Take your sample ballot or take a photo of or make notes about your choices as a "cheat sheet")

You will need to wear a mask and be socially distancing.

Caution: There will be fewer physical locations than in prior elections, so your polling place has most likely changed.

At the **Registrar's office** beginning **Oct. 29th Through November 2nd**, Saturday through Monday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

All Consolidated locations and the Registrar's office, will again be open on Election Day, Nov. 3, when the voting hours change to 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

CAN'T GO TO CONSOLIDATED LOCATION

What if you must use your Mail In ballot i.e. you have physical limitations, or the line at the consolidated Polling place is too long; you can drive through the Registrar of Voters parking lot, they will have well identified driving route through the parking lot to a tent where there will be 2 people who can take your ballot, insert it in a sealed container that container will be taken into the Registrar's office to be processed. Polling locations also have curbside voting—you can drive up to them and they have to bring your ballot out to you if you can't go in. Your "I Voted" sticker will be inside the VBM.

Please if you cannot do any of the above just contact one of the Board Members who can come to your house, pick up your ballot and drive it to your Polling place.

3 ways to improve your Get Out the Vote results:

When contacting Relatives, Friends, Neighbors for GOTV

Studies show you can improve voter turnout dramatically in these 3 ways...

Instead of saying...*Don't forget to Vote!* Say:

Are you going to **Be a Voter** in November?

1) If you are calling for a candidate, say I hope you are going to Be a Voter for Darrell Issa.

The personal-identity phrase "be a voter" increases turnout according to Stanford University Study.

To be implies good or noble character. Most people like to think this describes them.

Simply saying, *Don't forget to vote* or *Don't forget to take out the trash* is passive and easily dismissed.

2) Asking the voter if they know when they will vote or have a **plan to vote** improves voter turnout. This year that is very easy to ask since there are so many choices of when and where to vote...*"So, are you planning to vote in person or are you going to the ROV to drop off your ballot?"*

Remind all voters - **Voting early or in person is the very best way to be sure your vote is counted.**

Your local polling location will be printed on the back of your sample ballot. The Registrar of Voters will begin in person voting October 5. 5600 Overland Avenue, San Diego, 92123 858-565-5800

3) Mention that you are calling people to remind them about this important election and **may check back with them** later to see if they have any questions. Studies again have shown that groups of people that hear someone *may* call them back about their opinion on voting or the election will always out-vote those that don't hear that message!

These suggestions cost you nothing and require very little extra effort so try to include them when you are going through your list of Republican voters to "turn out" this year.



Reminder: 3rd Quarter GDP Report

You have until September 30 to make purchases or pay for services that will count in Quarter Three of GDP.

75% of the Economy is consumer spending on goods and services.

If you have plans to spend on items this fall, try to do so by September 30. Your spending will help raise the 3rd Quarter GDP score that President Trump will use to show the economy is improving. This will be the last reading of the economy before the election. We want it to be a good one.

Remember: No gift cards or cash gifts for Christmas presents if buying gifts early. You need to actually buy things and put them under the bed until Christmas! (Gift cards and cash don't count until actually redeemed or spent)



Reminder for Volunteers: If you will be calling using *i360* or other calling program for a candidate...before you leave home...

Make sure you know your Apple ID Password or your Google Account Information Password. You may need it for set up. The campaign staff can give you a personal account and password for *i360* use when you make calls for the campaign, but they have no knowledge of your own personal Apple ID Password or Google Account Info. These are the passwords you set up the day you purchased your phone and many of us have no idea what they are off the top of our head. Some phones will not let you add an app or pay for a product without first putting in this password. *i360* is easy to use. I choose the red "mobile" selection button to make calls. It is most like the direct dialing we are used to. 90% of the time you will be leaving a voice message. How hard is that?
