EARLY JUNE, 2020 TRAVEL GUIDELINES as of 05/19/20 issued in response to the Novel COVID-19 Pandemic by Monhegan Plantation's COVID-19 Task Force:

Please be aware that **from June 1st through June 14th** the Monhegan Boatline is limiting passengers per trip. Tickets are available on a first come, first serve basis. Please call well ahead of your arrival date to make a RESERVATION. For reservations in the final 24 hours prior to departure call Monhegan Boatline at (207) 372-8848. If no answer, contact Amy Barstow at <u>abarstow@monheganboat.me</u>, cell phone (207) 691-3435.

- Please postpone travel to Monhegan if you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or believe you have been exposed to COVID-19.
- The Maine Governor's 5/15/20 Update proposes opening of Maine lodging to Maine residents and non-residents who comply with the State's 14-day quarantine requirement, beginning June 1. Monitor https://www.maine.gov/covid19/ for relevant updates and executive orders to ensure you are following the latest travel guidance for June.
- Practice Physical Distancing of 6 feet on Wharfs, Boats & Monhegan.
- Bring a cloth face covering with you to wear on the Monhegan Boatline Wharf & Boats, on Monhegan Wharf *AND* on Monhegan Island, in accordance with the Maine Governor's Executive Order 49.
- If anyone in your party meets an exception listed below please alert the Boatline Office staff <u>as soon as possible</u> so accommodations can be worked out for crew & passenger safety.

Exceptions to the cloth face covering requirement:

- o child under age 2 or a child in a childcare setting.
- $\circ\;\;$ anyone who has trouble breathing or related medical conditions.
- o if unable to remove the face covering without assistance.

PLEASE DO YOUR PART TO KEEP COVID-19 FROM SPREADING TO THE BOAT CREW AND TO MONHEGAN.

Monhegan has <u>very limited</u> resources for COVID-19 emergencies. There is NO staffed health care facility on the island. Calls to 911 are responded to by a few island volunteers trained in basic first aid. Advanced EMS providers must travel from the mainland. Weather and other circumstances may delay care. There are only VERY LIMITED supplies of personal protective equipment, medical equipment (including thermometers), and hygiene & sanitation products available on island.
