

**Harmon Utterback Jr (1755-1854) P-308994**

Harmon Utterback was born 16 October 1755, in old Germantown, Prince William County, Virginia. He was the son of Henry Utterback (Johann Otterbach). He moved by 1794 first to Fayette County, Kentucky and then to Nicholas County. He died there in 1854. He married Elizabeth Crose about 1780. She was born 20 October 1757 in Culpepper County, Virginia, and died 10 May 1829 in Nicholas County, Kentucky. They had thirteen children.

Harmon Utterback enlisted in 1775 at the Culpepper County Court House in the Regiment of Colonel Lawrence Taliaferro and in a Company of Minute Men under Captain William McClanahan. In these Virginia Companies, Harmon fought under the famous "Rattlesnake Flag" at the Battle of the Great Bridge. Near the close of the War he fought under Colonel William Crawford and Captain Hankinson Reed of Culpepper County at the siege of Yorktown. After the surrender of Cornwallis, he served as a guardsman of the British prisoners on the march from Yorktown to Winchester, Virginia. Here he was discharged. He was pensioned in Nicholas County, Kentucky, in 1832.
