Fees:

Entry fees = Timed Events \$35 Round/ \$70 Total Rough Stock \$45 Round/ \$90 Total

Ground Fee = \$20 per contestant for the weekend.

RESERVATIONS & PRE-ORDERS

Stalls: \$75 for the weekend. This will include 2 bags of shavings. Additional shavings will be available to purchase. Stalls will be \$85 if purchased at the rodeo. Most Stalls are Concrete – so there will be a need for shavings, mats. Campsites w/Hookup - \$50 per night for 30 amp & \$60 per night for 50 amp (limited 50 amps) THERE ARE PLENTY OF CAMPING HOOKUPS AVAILABLE. HOOKUPS WILL BE ASSIGNED ON A 1ST COME BASIS.

GENERATORS will be allowed to be used. Per the venue rules every trailer not parked in a campsite will be charged a \$25 per day fee. So there is a fee even if you run generators.

Armbands for weekend admission: \$15 each — EACH CONTESTANT WILL BE GIVEN ONE GUEST ARMBAND AT NO COST. Daily Armbands will be \$10 /day at the door. Everyone MUST have an armband on.

T-shirts/ Sweatshirts: T-shirts will be offered pre-sale again this year. They will be pre ordered and there <u>WILL NOT</u> be a vendor on site. We may have a very small quantity to purchase on site. They will be offered in short-sleeve \$15, long sleeve \$20 and hoodie sweatshirts \$30.
