



January 9, 2021 - COVID Update

Greetings from Midway Nursing Home!

We currently have 1 asymptomatic COVID positive resident and all other residents and staff are COVID negative and remain asymptomatic. At the present time we have 1 floor on quarantine until approximately January 21<sup>st</sup>. As per Department of Health guidance, close monitoring of residents, isolation precautions, and limited movement of residents and staff continue until the end of the quarantine and all residents continue being tested weekly and our staff twice weekly.

Visitation is on pause until further notice. We encourage you to schedule a virtual visit with your loved one. Please contact a team member from Recreation or Social Services to schedule a virtual visit today!

All packages for residents sent via postal services or dropped off in person continue to be sanitized and held for 24 hours before giving to our residents so please plan accordingly as this includes laundry being dropped off.

CVS Health will return to our facility on January 20<sup>th</sup> to administer the 2<sup>nd</sup> doses and 1<sup>st</sup> doses of the COVID vaccine for newly admitted residents and residents who have not yet received. If you still need to give your consent for your loved one to receive the COVID vaccine, please call the facility as soon as possible to give your consent to a registered nurse.
